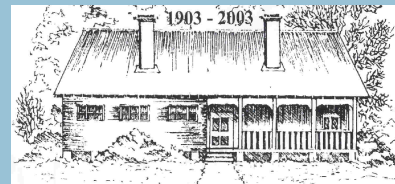

Kurri Kurri High School Gifted and Talented Students Enrichment Class 2013

Year 6 students who are attending Kurri Kurri High School in 2013 were given a note yesterday outlining the selection procedures for a new Year 7 Gifted and Talented student class which will run in 2013. To be considered for this class, students must be performing distinctly above average in areas of learning. Students will need to participate in two screening tasks – one creative writing task and one mathematics task. Teacher checklists, parent questionnaires and results from the screening tests will

determine the students from the local primary schools who will be part of this class. If you would like your child to be considered for this class you must speak with their class teacher by Monday, 19th November. Identified students will sit for the screening exams at Kurri Kurri High School on Thursday, 22nd November. Please be aware that this class is for Gifted and Talented students.
